The collection of articles will be posted on the website of the Institute of International Education for Study and Research of V.N. Karazin Kharkiv National University by calling <https://iie.karazin.ua>. The electronic version of the collection of scientific works can be downloaded from the site.

To participate in the conference **until April 12, 2025** to the e-mail address **movnapid1@karazin.ua** it is necessary to send **the text of the article** of design for the instructions below (name the file in Ukrainian or English with the last name and first name of the author – "Acar Helin_article") and **an application for participation in the conference** <https://forms.gle/G7xTKjGDBdHpm7Qq8>

Requirements for publication:

1. The length of the article is 3-5 pages of text (in Ukrainian or English) in A4 format.

2. Text in the Microsoft Word editor, font – Times New Roman, pin – 14, line spacing – 1.5. Page parameters: paragraph – 1.25 mm, all margins – 20 mm. Formatting – by width, without automatic transfers. Highlighting key concepts in bold is allowed.

3. References to literary sources in the text are placed in square brackets according to the model: [2: 27], where the first digit is the serial number of the source, the second is the number of the quoted page.

The list of used literature is drawn up in accordance with the standards of bibliographic description (DSTU 8302:2015).

We draw your attention to the inadmissibility of including sources published in Russian in the list of used literature.

4. Placement on the page: in the upper right corner – surname, first name of the author, name of the country; lower right – the name of the educational institution; further down – the name of the faculty, course of study, group number; on the next line – information about the scientific supervisor: scientific degree, academic title, position, surname and first name.

Information about the author of the article and the scientific supervisor is printed in italics, alignment on the right edge, pin – 14, line spacing – 1.0.

The title of the article is given after 2 lines (interline spacing – 1.0) from the information about the author of the article and the scientific supervisor (capital letters, center alignment, bold font, pin – 14).

After the title of the article, across a line (interline spacing – 1.0) – an abstract of the article. The length of the annotation is up to 500 characters in the language of the text of the article (pin – 12, line spacing – 1.0). After the annotation, key words are printed (5-8 words; italics, pin – 12).

After keywords in 2 lines (interline spacing – 1.0) – the text of the article.

The publication ends with a list of used literature. The word "References" is printed across a line after the text of the article in bold, centered alignment, pin – 12. A numbered list of sources used in alphabetical order is provided across a line (interline spacing – 1.0) (aligned to the width of the page, without paragraph indent, pin – 12, line spacing – 1.0).

5. When writing an article, please adhere to the principles of academic integrity. All posts will be checked for textual borrowings.

Articles, the design of which does not meet the specified requirements, will not be accepted by the editorial board.

We will be sincerely grateful for your cooperation and dissemination of information among fellow teachers and students.
